

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to <http://www.opendoorthrapy.net> and Open Door Therapy LLC and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to Open Door Therapy LLC include <http://www.opendoorthrapy.net> and Open Door Therapy. The Open Door Therapy website is a Mental health counseling private practice and newsletter site. By using the Open Door Therapy website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

We do not collect any personal information about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. However, you may be required to provide certain personal information to us when you elect to use certain products or services available on the Site. These may include: (a) registering for an account on our Site; (b) entering a sweepstakes or contest sponsored by us or one of our partners; (c) signing up for special offers from selected third parties; (d) sending us an email message; (e) submitting your credit card or other payment information when ordering an purchasing products and services on our Site. Automatically Collected Information
